### **Adjustment to the home-school agreement during the Covid-19 Pandemic**

In light of the significant changes, our home to school agreement has to be altered so that you know how we can work together most effectively.

#### **We (the school) will:**

- Carry out a thorough risk assessment to enable our school to run as safely as possible following the latest government guidelines for schools.
- Ensure that our staff maintain a high level of personal hygiene, in particular with regards to handwashing.
- Ensure that we encourage the children to wash their hands regularly and for at least 20 seconds.
- Ensure that your child is supervised if they are poorly while we are waiting for them to be collected.

#### **You (the Parents/Carers) will:**

- Follow the measures identified in the school's Covid risk assessment.
- Collect your child immediately if your child shows any symptoms of illness at school.
- Collect your child immediately if your child behaves in a way that puts themselves or others at risk; we will be unable to use normal de-escalation techniques or those involving positive handling.

#### **I (the Pupil) will try to:**

- Wash my hands for at least 20 seconds when I am asked to and before/after I eat anything.

- Use a tissue if I sneeze or need to blow my nose and put used tissues into the bin.
- Work and behave to the best of my ability at all times.
- Look after the whole environment of the school and my community, including online.
- Be friendly and helpful to everyone at school ensuring that I am caring and considerate.
- Keep the school's rules, including any new rules my teacher tells me.
