<p>Adjectival agreement.</p> <p>An introduction to the concept of adjectival agreement, in the simplest form in French.</p> <p>Adding an 'e' to the end of the adjective (in this unit the nationality, English or French) to show that the person talking or being described is female.</p>	<p>I IN IQUE ILLE • IN sound in cinq • I sound in huit, dix, Patrick, habite, Paris and suis • Silent letters.</p> <p>'S' is not pronounced in appelle, ans, Paris, Londres or habites. This often happens when 's' is the final consonant in a word. • Liaison. When a word that ends in a normally silent consonant, is followed by a word starting with a vowel as seen in je suis anglais/anglaise. Pronunciation will change when an 'e' is added to the end of anglais.</p> <p>• Elision. As seen in j'habite.
