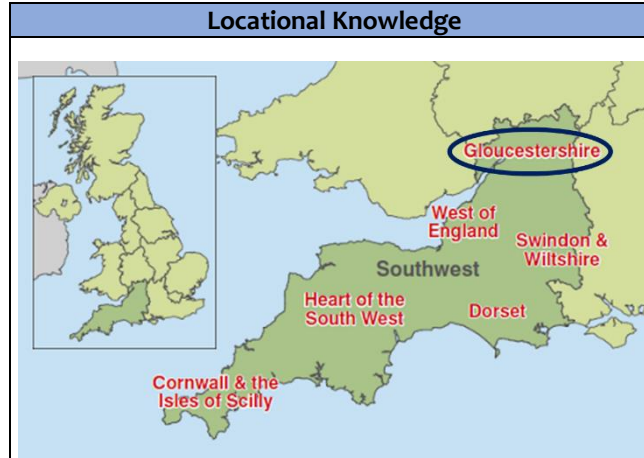

Geographical Skills and Enquiry
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Ask and respond to questions and offer their own ideas.</li> <li>Investigate places and themes at more than one scale</li> <li>Collect and record evidence with some aid</li> <li>Analyse evidence and draw conclusions</li> <li>Locate places on large scale maps</li> <li>Begin to identify significant places and environments</li> <li>Use junior atlases.</li> </ul>

What should I know by the end of the unit?
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>To know that the UK is divided up into different regions and counties.</li> <li>To locate where I live within the UK e.g. England, South West, Gloucestershire, Cheltenham, Charlton Kings.</li> <li>To recognise that jobs in the UK can be categorised into Primary, Secondary and Tertiary Sectors.</li> <li>To explain using regional knowledge, where more Primary, Secondary or Tertiary jobs take place.</li> <li>Analyse data from a local survey to be able to explain what job sector is most common in my local area, Charlton Kings.</li> <li>Conduct a fieldwork study to support my evidence from parent surveys.</li> </ul>

Key Vocabulary	
<b>Economic activity</b>	The amount of money a country sells and makes
<b>Primary sector</b>	Extracts and uses natural resources from the Earth
<b>Agricultural</b>	When things are cultivated, such as food, crops and farm animals or forestry
<b>Secondary sector</b>	Manufactures good using the natural resources provided by the Primary Sector
<b>Manufacturing</b>	Industry where things are made to be sold, such as clothing, toys or equipment
<b>Tertiary sector</b>	Provides a service to customers and their sectors of industries.
<b>Service</b>	Industry where people sell a service or a skill, such as banking, insurance or hospitality
