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**What should I already know?**

- I will already have learnt about:**
- Christians believe in one God, but they believe he exists in three parts. Jesus (the son) is God in the flesh.
  - The 'Gospels' are the life and teaching of Jesus.
  - Christians believe that Jesus' birth, life, death and resurrection were part of a longer plan by God to restore the relationship between humans and God.
  - Christians believe that Jesus is the Messiah and see him as their Saviour.

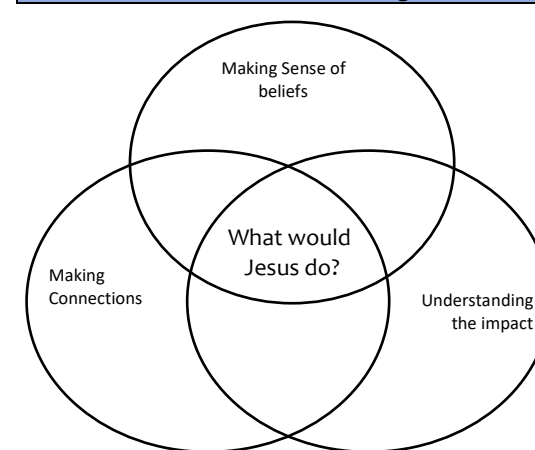
**What should I know by the end of the unit?**

- Make sense of beliefs:**
- Identify features of Gospel texts (for example, teachings, parable, narrative).
  - Taking account of the context, suggest meanings of Gospel texts studied, and compare their own ideas with ways in which Christians interpret biblical texts.
- Understand the impact:**
- Make clear connections between Gospel texts, Jesus' 'good news', and how Christians live in the Christian community and in their individual lives.
- Make connections:**
- Make connections between Christian teachings (e.g. about peace, forgiveness, healing) and the issues, problems and opportunities in the world today, including their own lives
  - Articulate their own responses to the issues studied, recognising different points of view.

**What will I learn about?**

- The life and teaching of Jesus and his use of parables.
- Gospel texts, for example: The Wise and the Foolish Builders, Matthew 7:24-27; Sermon on the Mount, Matthew 5-7; The Centurions Servant, Luke 7:1-10.
- Jesus' teaching about the two greatest commandments – to love God and love your neighbour (Matthew 22:36-40).
- Christian foundations for living:
  - Prayer
  - Justice
  - Healing
  - Forgiveness
  - Peace
- Problems in the world and examples of showing generosity to those in need.

**How do these ideas work together?**



Key Vocabulary	
Incarnation	God becoming man: God becoming flesh.
Salvation	Being saved from harm or ruin.
Messiah/Saviour	Christians believe that Jesus is the Messiah/Saviour. They believe that he was sent by God to save all people.
New Testament	The second part of the Christian Bible. It outlines the teachings of Jesus.
Disciple	A follower of Jesus during his life.
Gospel	These are four biblical narratives (stories) about the life and death of Jesus. They were written by: St Matthew, St Mark, St Luke and St John.
Good News	The message that Jesus and his disciples told people about God.
Parable	A simple story that Jesus used to get a message across.
